The information below is a guide to support you when discussing learner pathways with students.

When considering the best pathway for students we use the following information as a suggestion. We hope the information below will help you when discussing the choices, students have made as they enter the next stage of their learning.

| Description | Suggested route to support reaching potential |

| For students whose GCSE results are mainly grade A*- A's | We would suggest choosing 4 A levels. Skills Challenge (Welsh Baccalaureate) might be their fourth choice however a further A level would also be recommended. |
| For students whose GCSE results are mainly B&C grades | We would suggest choosing 3 A levels that might include a combination of A level and BTEC Courses plus studying the Skills Challenge (Welsh Baccalaureate). |
| For students whose GCSE grades are mainly C's and contain vocational course results | We would suggest choosing 2 A levels that might include a combination of A level and BTEC Courses plus Skills Challenge (Welsh Baccalaureate). |
